ourselves.' If we are to be in godly unity, we must be in unity with God. Getting in unity with God, however, in spite of what some may believe, is not the way to accomplish unity in the body of Christ. Before anyone runs home and tells their momma that I said, we need to be in unity with one another, and not with God, let me repeat what I said: To be in godly unity with one another, which is what we strive for we **must** be in unity with God. But being in unity with God, alone, will not bring unity in the body of Christ. We must do the work. We must do it. It makes no sense to preach the gospel to each other and think that will accomplish the great commission. We must do the work, just like the Lord told us to. If we believe getting into unity with God will accomplish unity in the body of Christ, it makes the same kind of sense as preaching to each other and thinking that will get the lost saved.

That all being said, working for unity without staying connected to the one who told us to get into unity, is like trying to fill the kids' swimming pool without the hose hooked up to the spigot.

People, we need to be talking to every believer we know or meet and reminding them what the Bible says about being in unity with the rest of the body of Christ.

Before you do this, however, realize that some will listen and some will not. When they do not listen, do not be discouraged. Do not stop talking to other believers. To do this, it is best to enlist the aid of someone close and always take it to the Lord.

Some will listen because you are telling the truth of Almighty God. Some will not listen because they may believe, like far too many do, that they have the whole truth and no one else does. 



"I Tim 3:1, 'Here is a trustworthy saying," Herman Parks the Bible teacher told the people at Christ the King at the ordination of James Walker. "If anyone sets his heart on being an overseer, he desires a noble task.' Heb 5:4, 'No one takes this honor upon himself; he must be called by God.' For what reasons would a man desire the office of Bishop? Satan gains access to us by the way that we think. Keeping your mind on the good things is keeping your mind on the Lord. People do not appoint themselves bishops; they are appointed and anointed by God.

"Can you seek the Lord when your money is gone, when your house burns down? Can you seek him in the rough times?

"I found him in a pit, in a prison, with Mama on a sick bed, when I had no friends. He is more than enough. Though he slay me, yet I will trust him. Old things have passed away. All things are made new. You are about to grab hold of something that has been out of your reach. It cannot happen, however, until you get into his presence.

"About 0230 this morning, God gave me this word for you, this church, this region. The only way you can receive elevation from God is through being tried, mishandled, through disappointment, times when God seems not to be there. Moses said, 'Lord, I know there is much more to this.' There is a greater place in God that he wants us to be, but we must be with him faceto-face. I don't have to die in this body for that. I will see it while I still breathe in this body.

"Sometimes people will introduce you to something that sounds good, but it's not the Holy Ghost. It has a form of godliness, but denies the power thereof. What use is there of a title with no power? We cannot get there with titles, but with clean hands and a pure heart, and by the Lord leading us, not people.

"Some people say God abandoned us. Sometimes God is not good enough for us church folks. God says, 'Have I not been good enough?'

"I came to stop you from drowning yourself. The Lord showed me foundations. The Holy Ghost said, 'Now, run tell that.' A lot of us are asking for something that is not in God's interest and we get caught up in titles. The Lord told me, 'I send you as a modern day Ezekiel.

"A bishop is a desired office. I preached this before, but the pastor stopped speaking to me. I'm gonna say some things that will make you uncomfortable. People had a desire to have a king, so God gave them Saul held back, prolonged and delayed. He was not looking for sheep, but for donkeys - disobedient, rebellious, stubborn, wanting to transform the generation.

"I Sam 17:39, David put on Saul's armor and it was just in his way. Don't let people put you in a place where God did not intend you to be. Somebody says, 'I see God called you to be an apostle.' You get this title, but that title will not go to war for you. Take the lesson from David; take it off so you can do what must do for God. Wait until $\underline{\mathbf{God}}$ tells you to put it on.

"God told me to give you this, Is 43:18-19. Most of it comes from generational curses. They wanna have it the way they want it instead of how God wants it. So the momma syndrome attacks you. The daddy syndrome attacks you.

"Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah (Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego separated themselves from people that would bow down to anything.. God says, 'If you get out of the way, I will fight the battle.' Forget the former things. Don't dwell on the past; forget about it. Don't keep going over old history. Be alert, holy, acceptable - not to men, but to God, and you will behold something brand new just bursting out. There comes a time when you have to see what god is bursting out in the spirit realm."

The prophet began prophesying over people, beginning with Brian Glass.

"God says, 'I am making a road for you and your family. I will not take you out of the desert, but make a road for you through it and make rivers through it.' Folks think you're gone. Your finances, marriage, children, and health are not looking good, but he creates something from nothing.. All you have to do is birth it and see it.

"In this alliance is division and dissention. There was an attorney, who is now deceased, that was defending a case. He said, 'If it doesn't fit, you must acquit.'

The prophet prophesied over Bishop James Walker, "God said of Bishop Walker, 'I'm not trying to give him two churches, but a greater life.' The organization is yet to organize the demonstrated power of oneness. Therefore, for the last 90 days, you have been sent an agitator, He's not after you; he's after the Son. Titles

As some people may be aware, I edit the Battlefield News. Therefore, I am concerned with what is **grammatically** correct. People that have been around the body of Christ very long can see some of the problems with titles. Others, unfortunately, do not see. Titles are useful. In moderation and when appropriate, they are a positive thing. In the body of Christ, they are far too often misused, used inappropriately, and cause much dissention and strife. They pump too many egos and cause too many problems.

Grammatically speaking many of the titles we hear and see are not actual titles. For instance, "apostle," "prophet" (or prophetess), "evangelist," "teacher," "missionary," and "reverend" are <u>not</u> legitimate titles. That is why you never see "Reverend Martin Luther King Jr," but instead yos see <u>the</u> reverend <u>Doctor</u> Martin Luther King Jr. No where in the Bible do you ever see "Apostle Paul," "Apostle Peter," or "Apostle John." Instead, what you see is, "John the apostle", or "<u>the</u> apostle Paul."

In John 13, Yeshua removed his outer clothing and wrapped a **towel** around his waist. He washed the feet of his disciples, s task assigned to servants, to those of low social rank. In John 13:14, he tells us to wash each other's feet. It's not that we should do that literally, but figuratively – we should humble ourselves with our brothers. Too many of us, however, have allowed our titles to become far larger than our towels, When our titles become bigger than our towels, bad things tend to happen. I say this because the truth is that our towels are much more important than our titles.

One thing that happens is that we and others trip all over out titles. For some, the fact that they have the title "apostle" becomes more important than the being sent out (apostle means to be sent out on a special mission).

For some, the fact that they have the title "prophet" becomes more important than delivering the message from God and people trip over that title because most Christians believe that a prophet is some kind of fortune teller, when clearly the majority of things that came from prophets in the Bible had nothing to do with predicting the future.

For some, having the title "missionary" becomes more important than the actual mission; having the title "evangelist" becomes more important than the evangelizing.

The work, as most people can see, is more important than the title. We have made titles more important than they were ever intended to be, especially those named in the "five-fold ministry." Pastor is a legitimate title, grammatically speaking. Doctor is a legitimate title. Captain, General, and Admiral are titles, as are President and officer. But not every title uttered is a grammatically correct title.

In the body of Christ it seems like everyone must have a title. If I don't have a title, one will be assigned to me. I will be referred to as "Brother Rick." Some say that we should call each other by titles like brother or sister because we are brothers and sisters in Christ. I know that I am only speaking for myself in this, but it makes me feel like a phony to call everyone "Brother," or "Sister. I say this because I have a brother. His name is Jared. He is actually my brother, but he has never called me "Brother Rick;" he just calls me Rick. There are (to me) some exceptions to this. There are some people in the body for whom being referred to as "Brother" has been done so often that it just fits - for instance, Brother Pineapple (the evangelist Les Vinluan), but to call everyone brother or sister just seems like nonsense. But as I said, I am speaking only for myself. One thing is true about this practice, however, and it is not just me, and that is the fact that it is not grammatically correct.

In Mat 20:25-28, Yeshua said to his boys, 'The rulers of the Govim (Gentiles) lord it over them and their high officials exercise authority over them. Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be your slave - just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and give his life as ransom for many.' If the Lord we worship came to serve and not to be served, what does that tell us we should be doing? He said in Mat 10:24, 'A student is not above his teacher, nor a servant above his master.' Yeshua, while he was here on earth, was the Lord, and was called "Lord;" he was a teacher and was called teacher. Titles must be used sensibly and appropriately. If everyone has a title, then soon, a title comes to mean nothing.

Another thing that happens when our titles become larger than our towels is that we begin to believe that our function in the body is our rank. We begin to believe that our rank places us over someone else. This is pride - the very thing that ruined Lucifer. You see Pride does not care about being good at something, only about being better at it than someone else, about being higher up the ladder than someone else. This is un-Christian. It is just as prideful to not allow someone else to be over us. Our function is not our rank. Basing titles on our functions encourages this misunderstanding. Sometimes it is valid, but too often it is not. If I am the shepherd of my flock, it is valid to say, "Pastor Rick." This is actually grammatically correct, as is Bishop or Senator. It is not, however, grammatically correct to address me as "Apostle Rick", "Prophet Rick", "Evangelist Rick," "Minister Rick," Reverend Rick," or "Missionary Rick." This is just as absurd as calling someone "Librarian Jill," "Plumber Bob," or "Mechanic Jerry." Let us not be so proud that we need our function to be a title. Brothers and sisters in Messiah, please, let's be carful with the titles. They can be more damaging than we realize.

"We in Manaus and Inenduba are the most blessed people on earth to be able to do this with this ministry.

"There is a little girl whose step mother would not feed her with her own children, but instead cut her, dipped grass into her blood and made her eat it. Someone reported it, but when we got her, she was skin and bones. At three-years-old, her father came to rape her.

"The law says we cannot have more than 20 kids in a house, but the law does not fit reality. In one house we have more than 60. The number one thing you can do is pray. Another thing is to go down there yourself."

call on these gifts. This unity thing – it is working better and better because we stuck to it. We did not give up on it, or on each other, and God did not give up on us. Disunity is from the devil. In Acts 2, they were together in one accord. How can we

teach the world the truth when the 'truth' causes us such disunity? The command is unity and this is not supposed to cost us the essentials. We should compel people to serve and testify. Your testimony will affect somebody. I promise. A testimony is often better than the best sermon. We need to be building a church without walls. Get out there and witness to people. Preachers, preach under the gazebo in Winder or in Hoschton. They told Pastor Roger Williams he could not come back and preach because he <u>did</u> preach to make a difference. If God puts it in your heart to pray for someone, do it right then; don't tell them you will pray for them. We don't have the big numbers, but it is working. Don't be discouraged because in any church it is 5 to 10% who do all the work."



Pastor Joyce Heard of Athens Unity Fellowship "Hello, welcome to the second night of revival," Pastor Joyce Heard told the people. Let the worshipers arise. Let God arise in your life and all your enemies will scatter. God will make your name great as you bring glory and honor to him. Michael (spoken to Pastor Michael Young), God is going to answer that which you have been praying about. Your ministry will never be the same. Get ready. Get ready. Get ready.

"Don't open that box. Look to your left. Now look to your right. These are not your enemies. You have one enemy – the devil. We are all sent to this earth to solve a problem. It's how you live."

"The teacher comes out in me," said Sherry Angel. "This is the <u>me</u> generation. We taught them how to be **self**-confident, but we never taught them humility. They don't know how to look at others

because it is all about <u>I</u>. Why are we not in unity? The enemy will get us through offense – offenses can make us resentful and bitter. We act like we don't know who the enemy is. It is not our brothers and sisters. You say, 'But you don't know what they did to me.' Well, God does and shows us how to deal with it in this book." She said this as she held up the Bible. "You take that offense and place it in a box. Then you keep on opening it, looking at it, saying, 'Look what they did to me.' You don't have to keep looking in there. If you cannot get over something, you are telling on yourself.

"If we are not in unity, we must ask two questions:

- 1: Are you studying to show yourself approved?
- 2: Are you renewing your mind?

"We are all falling short on giving God the honor and glory," Pastor Allen Stevens of Living Hope Christian Fellowship said. "When we praise God through song, we don't need to take anything for granted. We must teach our children about the Bible and pray for them. We are not the silent majority. We must arise, let our lights shine, and let everybody know who we work for. We speak the word of God and we are the oracles. God has called us to take care of things. If we don't do it, who will? The world thinks we are crazy. I <u>am</u> a fanatic for Jesus, a holy roller. But no one will hear us if we are the silent majority."



Barry Hall of the Father's Heart

"If what I am doing will not make a difference in eternity, it is not worth doing. One thing on God's heart is orphans. God brought us into a city where they practice infanticide because it is necessary to keep the curse off the tribe. In America children are killed for much smaller reasons. We are the body of Christ. We have the answers to solve the problems in the world; not the United Nations or the world banking systems – us!

In Brazil, we had to come to the realization that we cannot take in any more children. We already have more than 60. In one day we had to turn away 18 kids that we would never have turned away. Still, we feel like the most blessed people on earth. We get to see kids rescued and changed. We get the kids rescued by the government and it is our job to get the children out of the orphanage and into placement as soon as possible. We hope it is back to the parents after the parents are re-educated, or to relatives. If there are no relatives, then we try for adoption. If they are older than two-years-old, it is

much more difficult. If there are siblings, it is **very** difficult. If the child has special needs, it is almost impossible. The Brazilian government wants Brazilians to have first crack at adoption, but if there are no Brazilians to adopt, the children are up for international adoption. We presently have 38 employees and they are not enough. You can find out a whole lot by going to thefathersheartbrazil.org.

"We need prayer cover more than anything. It is the key to solving all out problems. These children are taken to church every Sunday, defying Brazilian law. The devil does not want us there, but we know if the devil is not on our back, we are not doing anything. We need funds. You may think \$5.00 is nothing, but God multiplies the money. Five dollars can become \$500.00 or \$5000.00. It takes about \$40,000.00 per month to run the home. We are trying to break this cycle one child at a time. If you want to learn more about us, get with Rick or Jody, or we will sit down and talk to you one-on-one, show you the photographs. Please come along beside us."



Scott Sutherland of Holy Ghost Tabernacle

"Unity is not being multiple," Scott Sutherland told the people at the third night of revival. "being one, being in one accord, unification. How do we get there?

"Jesus came to the area of the Decapolis in Mark 5:18-20. He met a demoniac, whom he delivered. The people herding the pigs told him they did want him there, so he left. The demoniac wanted to leave with him, but Jesus told him to go home and tell what God had dome for him.

"When Jesus came back to the Decapolis in Mark 7:31-32, the people came out to meet him and brought a man for him to heal. Why was it different this time? It was different because of the testimony of the demoniac. Never underestimate the power of one voice speaking out for Jesus.

"The mission is simply one beggar telling another beggar where to find bread. If I keep it to myself, I will answer to God for it later.

"You can be extraordinary at the door to McDonalds, At Walmart, at home with your kids, praying at the altar with little ones. You don't have to be a Billy Graham; just share."



Moneka Dixon, author of Purple Butterfly: the Process of Becoming

"Eph 1:22-23 tells us that Christ has been placed over everything. It is not a building, but a living, breathing organism. I Cor 12:12 tells us the body is like a human body with many members. What destroys unity? Pride destroys unity. The body of Christ is not corporate America. Your gifts are not based on your past so that you earn a title. Our gifts are not based on what we did or how well we did. These titles: Jesus is not concerned with your title, so don't think you are more valuable according to your 'title.' Jesus humbled himself as a servant, and even further, to the cross. Without him, none of us is anything. Our gifts, even our lives are not about us. We may have mastered something and then look down on others. What? These people you are looking down on are part of the body. It may be our nature to focus on our differences because we all come from different backgrounds. Stop focusing on our differences. Stop allowing our earthly organizations and associations to cause disunity among us - things like whether we are a Republican or a Democrat. We are the body of Christ and we must stay unified, remembering that we must never allow anything to cause disunity



"I didn't come to preach," Pastor Billy Angel of Kingdom Life Refuge said at the fourth installment of the seven-day revival, "but I didn't come not to. We can't be in God if we aren't living godly lives. We have to live our lives according to this Bible or else we'll be in unity with the devil. As Christians, many of us have been deceived by pastors in our past. Mat 7:15, watch out for false Christians. They act like they have it all together, but they don't. Inwardly, they are wolves. Can you pick grapes from a thornbush? If I am living a false life - a life not according to this Bible - we can't do the miracles. If you try to pick grapes from a thornbush, you will get hurt. False Christians are sinning Christians. If you cuss around me, I will tell you about it. I did not come to teach you the laws; you know them and don't obey half of them. I get to preach the funeral of an 18-year-old girl tomorrow. I asked God, 'Why did you take her?' He slapped me upside the head and said, 'Wrong question. Ask me why I gave them this girl for 18 years.'

"Not everyone who says, Lord, Lord, will be in heaven. What words are we putting into practice? I can cast these things out of your life, but you can walk right out of here and do them again. Whatever it is that is keeping us from being in unity, I cast it out of all of us, including myself. If we get the sin out of our lives, we can do this. We are God's sons. Can we continue to do the things and listen to the things that he does not approve of? The kids were listening to Rap, so I told them, if you can't play that in church, you're not supposed to be listening

to it. Whatever it is that you are listening to, you are in worship, realize it or not. Will you worship the devil? You have a purpose for God. Are those in your family going to heaven with us? Just believing in God doesn't mean much. The devil believes in God. If you don't know where you are gonna go, you can change that tonight.

"Get out from in front of the TV. You have an Asherah pole in your house and you don't even know it. The spirit of lust is in our homes and in our churches, but we pretend that it's okay and holy. God wants us to fulfill his purposes. Jesus said to preach the kingdom. The kingdom is here now!

2: Do we **consider** others in our decision-making? Selfishness causes division. It will destroy unity. Selfishness destroys, Hag1:5-7

3: Do we **consider** the consequences of our sins? We know that according to Rom 6:23, the wages of sin is death. That seems so extreme. Most people don't **consider** that they will die **from** their sins. We must be aware of the fact that we <u>all</u> sin – Rom 3:23. Some people won't even acknowledge that they have sin, but we all know that no matter how much we try, we all fall short at times. Look up the following scripture: Ecc 7:20, Mat 7:3, and Mat 7:13-14.

4: Do we **consider** how important our role in the body of Christ is and that we are to be in unity? All my life growing up in church, I never heard anything about unity until I was 30 something. Don't let the forces of darkness tell you that you can't be used in the body. We all have a part to play no matter what our past is.

5: Ecc 7:13, do we **consider** the ways we can serve God and spread his love? At Tender Love there are 32 kids. It takes \$270.00 to feed them every week. I have provided this for many weeks. That may be my portion, but there are many other portions. If I can do something, why can't you?

To curse doesn't necessarily mean witchcraft. Prov 18:21, the words we speak release either death or life, Ps 141:3. The grace of God cannot be compromised. Paul said, 'Even if an angel in heaven preaches a different gospel, let him be cursed.' If anyone tampers with the true message of grace, let them be cursed. The Greek word is anathema.

"Those who turn away from Jesus to another 'way to salvation,' read Num 21:3 - 'utterly destroy the Canaanites. Josh 6:16-17, the city of Yericho was totally destroyed. Today it is not politically correct to be absolute about anything, but the gospel is absolute. Acts 4:12, there is <u>no</u> other name! Absolute! John 14:6, 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father but by me. We need to be assured we are preaching the same gospel as Paul and therefore be as bold as Paul. I Pet 4:11, 'If anyone speaks, he should do it as one speaking the very words of God.' I Cor 1:10, speak the same thing. The degree of unity Paul describes here is awesome. 'Be perfectly joined together in the same mind. This rules out mere tolerance. In Romans chapters 14 & 15, Paul made allowances for differences in belief for less important things. There is room for these differences, but not for

critical differences or for discrimination against those weaker. Paul called legalistic Christians unrepentant and hard-hearted, for instance, if they trust in circumcision. We see in Rom 14 that there was room for different beliefs, but that some point were nonnegotiable. Paul did not compromise. The motive is what must be judged. Paul did not object to circumcision, only in faith in circumcision. This was the case in Acts 16:3. Eph 2:8, salvation by grace through faith, therefore there is room for Christians to have differences. In I Cor 15, Paul enumerates those things that are nonnegotiable.

"Today divisions are so common place that very few have unity in the body as a goal. We have become used to denominational divisions and do not take heed so that there is division within denominations, hence new denominations are formed. In that there is no real fellowship with each other. That is not what Paul was teaching.

"God is not the one who started all these denominations; it is the work of the forces of darkness so that the effectiveness of the body would be limited. I am not saying that people in denominations are of the devil, nor that the denominations are, but that the walls that are built because of the denominations <u>are</u> from the devil.

midst of you that make you pay attention. I learned in the last three weeks or so that, no matter what you think or feel, it is about Jesus and we <u>are</u> one. He said, 'Whatever you do to the least of these...'" Sometimes we treat the least as if they were nothing. Whatever you do to them, he said you do to him. He even loves the child molester just as much as he loves me

"The longest prayer in the Bible that Jesus prayed was that in John 17. We talk about this and we are not talking about everybody in this country or the world. We are not even talking about everybody in the alliance because they do not work to become one because they are not in the Holy Spirit. In Ezekiel the bones were not just detached,

but they were dry. These were the body of Christ. God, can we do something? God, can they live? Tell those bones they are no good because they must be Baptist or Presbyterian or Methodist, they must be black, they must be white, they must wear dresses down to the floor. Right? No!

"Prophesy to those bones. God has given us power and authority. If your people are not acting right, prophesy. God says if there are any virtuous things, speak on these.

"My feet used to be good-looking, but with time, as they worked in grease and dung and ugliness, they became ugly. I was working in the church barefoot and I kicked some glass. The glass got into it. I got bandages on the injury, but my belly is too big to reach it. So Theresa and Ja'Resa have to do it. They just put aside that ugliness to help me. They kept going and they never quit. Ja'Resa wanted to be a chef, now she wants to be a nurse. In the body of Christ there is ugliness and homeliness. There are those with not teeth, those that chew tobacco. We help them anyway because when we do it for the least of these, we do it for him.

"If we are coming together in unity, why are we? Someone has to be sanctified and clean. God asked me, 'What if you had to walk away from everything?' I told him, 'It won't matter, as long as you get the glory.'

"These are the things we've become. The Holy Spirit wants us to be so concerned about God, that it doesn't matter about us. That is when God says, 'Now we will make it about you.' Like Avraham (Abraham) and Yitzchak (Isaac), He sees you give your all and he takes care of it. He deserves it: he gave his all. Tell your people this. A lady came to me needing \$150.00 for her water bill. She was one of the least of these because she did not have Jesus. God is concerned about these things, but he is more concerned about your soul and your position with him. Every body is not going to be Shlomo (Solomon); some will be John the Baptist. He was the cousin of Jesus and he still lost his head. We have to give it all for him. That's where the body comes in. I Cor 12:13-18, who set the members? God set the members. You do not get to choose. God sets it.

"When we preach the truth, it's like castor oil; it might be hard going in, but everything comes out alright. You have to do what you don't wanna do for the sake of the body. We till the ground. We must till ourselves as well.

"Sometimes the least of these don't get what they need and we watch them have to keep going through the same things. James 1:26, it is worthless. When Jesus comes in, sin goes to the sea of forgetfulness. Thank God for the word; it makes us free."

big before I knew Jesus. After that, they just looked small. Jehoshaphat was seeking the Lord because of fear and he proclaimed a fast.

"There is a problem with the churches: we don't seem to realize we are fighting an unseen enemy. God has shown me the enemy, how to pray, how to break these things down.

"II Chron 20:5-6, we need to be encouraged. That's what this revival is about. We serve a mighty God, who has things stored up for us we cannot even imagine. V_9 , fear can drive us straight into the arms of God. V_{12} , God, our eyes are upon you. He wants to help us, but we need to be on our knees."



Pastor Patsy Sherwood of Arcade CH Church "II Chron 6:36," began Pastor Patsy, tagging Pastor Johnny and preaching, "Seek God for <u>his</u> wisdom to know how to lead. Without it, we can lead nothing. We can enter the holy of holies. Jesus

" $V_{12.14}$, He told Solomon, 'If **my people** (not those in the world) who are called by my name humble themselves and pray and seek my face (not my hand but my face – we are too busy giving him our whole list) and **turn** from their wicked ways...' Humility and turning will save the land. This land is screaming for help and it is up to the church to bring this help. If a conduit is all plugged up, nothing can flow. We are the conduit and if we are not united regardless of our differences, we are plugged up. Let God work in us. V_{15} , If we don't do what he says in V_{14} , forget about what he says in V_{14} , forget about what he says in

man who lost his hand in Viet Nam had it grown back. Someone hired a bouncer to attack the pastor. He did go there and he gave his life to Christ. When people pulled into the town, the presence of God was so palpable, that they just wept. If you did not get there by 1200, you would not get a seat, but that was alright because God manifested in the parking lot. Tonight there is an anointing on me that you will feel, but if God shows up, you don't have to be in church; you can be in Wal-mart. In Brownsville it was not just that church, but all the churches in the area began to fill up because people were not concerned about the preacher, but the Holy Ghost.

"Brownsville was not the only great revival. These were also in Toronto, Missouri, New York, and in Wales. No in Wales ever heard of Evan Roberts, but over three months over 100,000 were saved. When a real revival comes, the police are not needed. Is this what we want? Shake Walmart. Shake the drug dealer's house. I was a Holy Ghost nut and prayed for everybody. I went to the house of a drug dealer and prayed for her and she got

saved. Seven more people came to buy drugs and got saved. Was it the person? No, it was the Holy Ghost.

"In New York City there was a strip club across the street from a church where revival broke out. It was owned by a Mafioso. People from the strip club kept getting saved. The owner was going to go tell the pastor off and he got saved, closed the strip club, and became the main giver at the church.

"There are prerequisites for revival. In the 1700s, God lead the white people to make peace with the Indians. In 1906 on Azusa street, the revival ran for six months and the board figured that was long enough and fired the pastor. So God used a one-eyed black man, William Seymour. Many people came against him and against this revival. The fear of finally filled the area after the great earthquake of 1906. The same sort of thing happened briefly after 9/11. Remember?

"I am concerned for the church in our country. Americans cannot pray for more than 15 minutes because they have to have a commercial break. Revival has conditions.

The refreshing comes from the Lord's presence, not from great preaching, but from his presence. His presence does not only happen in church; it comes in hospitals, parking lots, and at the grocery store. But we must be prepared. You cannot put new wine in old wine skins. There must be preparation. The reason you do not have revival is that you are willing to live without it. The Lord will change our heart. The most challenging thing to me is to live what I preach. I said, 'Lord, I'm having a hard time living what I'm preaching.' He said, 'That's because you preach <u>mv</u> standards, not yours. The wineskin he is looking for must be all about him. Blessed are those that mourn for they shall be comforted.

David Brainerd once said, 'I found in myself that I had done nothing for God that was **only** for his glory, but everything I have done had some self interest in it.'

"I wanna do things solely for God's glory. I told him and then I wept because I realized that I wanted revival because I love my country. It is one of the few countries where we are free to worship God without somebody kicking the door in. People are not loading up caravans to get out, but to get in. We do need revival. I began to pray, 'Lord, even if this country falls, send revival anyway so that you will get the glory. It doesn't matter if they like me or hate me as long as you be glorified.'

"What will you do that will impact the body a hundred years from now? We have to come into unity because the attitude in Gen 6:5 (evil continually) is a demonstration of selfishness, self-centeredness, self, self. The greatest two commandments are to love the Lord and to love your neighbor as yourself.

"Y'all are not novices; most of you are seasoned veteran ministers of the gospel. That does not mean that God will not bless us. Everything we do, we are to do for his glory. In John 16, Jesus said the Holy Ghost would 'glorify me.' If the Holy Ghost is my comforter, then everything is supposed to be for the glory of God. We can't pray to God to send the fire and then try to tell him what to burn.

"Revival – real revival may cause your doubters not to like you. You still want it? People want it so their church will grow. If not, do you still want it? I believe now that there really are people who are only interested in the Lord glorified. The Holy Ghost wants to use you and me to glorify Jesus. He wants us to move at Walmart, to move past the preacher, past the denomination in that area. We have to get back to the Bible, back to the blood, preach his word whether people like you or not. When we speak the truth in love, he will move."

Prayer for This Land

Back in the 1970s I knew an old lady. Her name was Ms Thelma Beckham and she was on fire for Jesus. She always spoke so freely of her savior. I was very young then and did not know the Lord. But I am convinced that because of Ms Thelma's prayers, I asked her Lord to be the Lord over me in 1989, some years after ms Thelma. She gave me many Christian books, some over a hundred years old. In fact, those who make room for evil, even unwittingly are in the majority, but the land is still filled with those of us who love you.

Please, do not destroy your people, your gentle people, who founded this land only with your help. Actually, Lord, you founded this land.

It was you who defeated our enemies.

It was you who gave us this land and defeated our enemies

Our fathers put together what they could in prayer and supplication, but it was you who founded this land.

Oh Lord of all that is, please, save us.


