On Prayer 89 Call to Prayer (Part Two)

In Luke 11:1 one of the Talmidim (disciples) of Yeshua (Jesus) asked him to teach them how to pray. In response to this, Yeshua taught them the prayer that **we** call "The Lord's Prayer." In Mat 6:9 is this prayer in its entirety. In many English translations it begins, "Say this." Jesus was, however, giving them a model of how to pray, not something to recite. In Mat 6:9 we see, "Pray in this manner, 'Our Father who is in Heaven, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on Earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us of our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. For yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory for ever'" (ESV).

This brief prayer from the lips of Yeshua is not something for us to just recite. Even though there is nothing wrong with reciting it, let's not miss what the Lord was trying to show us using this model prayer. He was not just telling us to recite this prayer; he was showing us the essential ingredients that make the life of prayer work.

His prayer opens with adoration of the Father and reveals Yeshua's earnest desire to pray in accordance with the Father's will. In the scriptures we find the will of God in its entirety. From this we may safely conclude that our praying will be effectual only when stays very close to the will of God as we see it in his word. The youngest of the original 12 apostles was Yochanan (John). He was probably about 16 when he began to follow Jesus with his older brother Ya'akov (James). He was the only one that did not die a martyr's death and lived to be at least 90 years-old. As an old man, he did many wondrous things including being the pastor of the church at Ephesus, recording the book of Revelation and writing the Gospel of John as well as three epistles. In one of those epistles, First John, he confirms that closely adhering to the will of the Father in our prayers makes answers to prayer more likely. I John 5:14-15 says, "And we have this confidence in him, that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us in regard to whatever we ask, we know that what we have asked him for is ours" (NAB).

How do we know when we are praying according to the Father's will? Our prayers are always in line with the will of God when we **pray according to his word**. Praying the word of God brings answers to the human heart directly from the heart of God.

The basis for all of the wonderful blessings we enjoy as children of the King (all the scriptural promises of answered prayer) is seen in the love of the Father for his children. The apostle John wrote, "Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. Whoever does not love does not know God, because **God is love** (I John 4:7-8 NIV).

God loves you! There is no greater truth in the entire universe. Jesus said, "Ask, and it shall be given you, seek, and ye shall find, knock, and it shall be opened unto you. For everyone that asketh receiveth: and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. Or

what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will give him a stone? Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent? If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, How much more shall your Father who is in Heaven give good things to them that ask him?" (Mat 7:7-11 KJV).

The **power** as well as the **love** of God, through the Ruakh HaKodesh (Holy Ghost), will invade your life when you pray according to the will of God as we see it in his word. He is there to guide you and to sustain you. The Father's love is there to uphold you. Jesus, the word made flesh, indwells your prayer life and he ever lives to make intercession for you according to the will of God.

Pass the Mic: Daniel (Part Five)

The terms "man of sin," and "son of perdition," both refer to the end-time leader we call the antichrist. He is also known as that wicked one, the beast, and he is known by several other names. Now, the apostle Paul teaches here that the antichrist will stand in the temple exalting himself above all those that are called God, or that which is worshiped. So that he (the antichrist) sitteth in the temple as God, Showing himself that he is God. Now, this is the reason that it is called the abomination of desolation. Almighty God said repeatedly in the Old Testament, "I will put my name here," speaking of the Temple Mount, speaking of Jerusalem,

and in particular, of the temple itself. God said that he would put his name there forever.

Now, since God said, "I will put my name there," Satan wants to displace God, and put his name there. When the antichrist commits this blasphemous act, that will be the abomination of desolation. The institution of the Palestinian-Israeli peace agreement, begins Daniel's 70th week. This means, God will resume his plan for the Jews, for the next 7 years. However, it does not mean that he will turn away from the Gentiles. There was a Jewish and Gentile church together after the 69th week was fulfilled. There will still be a Jewish and Gentile church together during the 70th week. So, God did not leave the Jews completely once the 69th week stopped. He also will not leave the Gentiles completely once the 70th week begins, at the signing of the Palestinian Israeli peace agreement.

So, how would we know that the agreement that is signed is the one that will trigger the final 7 years? First, it will place the Temple Mount under a sharing arrangement. Second, it will allow the building of Israel's Temple on the Temple Mount, without disturbing the Dome of The Rock and the Al-Aqsa Mosques.

Here is the proof : Revelation 11:1-2 says, "And there was given me a reed like unto a rod (in other words a long strait measuring stick): and the angel stood, saying, 'Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein (i.e. the part where the people worship), but the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; (Why?), for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months.'" God told John to measure the Temple and the people who are worshipping there. Now, this happens 3 ½ years before the battle of Armageddon and the second advent (coming). So, here we have evidence that the Temple Mount is going to be under a sharing arrangement.

John was told to measure the Temple and those that worship therein. Do not measure the outer court, which will continue under Gentile control. The Dome of The Rock, and the Al-Aqsa Mosque, those are Muslim shrines that are located in what would have been called the outer court of the Jewish Temple. So, God said not to measure that. Now, here is what is going to happen. This will also allow Jews to stay in Shomron (Samaria). There are 850,000 Jews living in that area right now. They are going to be allowed to stay there as part of the Israeli-Palestinian peace agreement.

This is illustrated in Mat 24:15-21 where Jesus said, "When you see the abomination of desolation spoken of by the prophet Daniel, standing in the holy place (let the reader, understand), then let them who are in Judea flee into the mountains. Let the one who is on the housetop not go down to take what is in his house, and let the one who is in the field not turn back to take his cloak. And alas for women who are pregnant and for those who are nursing infants in those days! Pray that your flight be not in the winter or on a Sabbath. For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been from the beginning of the world until now, no, and never will be" (ESV).

Jerusalem shall be under the control of Israel, but the final status of Jerusalem will be left unresolved. We see this from Zech 14:2, where it says, "And I will gather all the (see pg 4)

All Lives Matter (Part One)

Battlefield News Note: Last month we published a letter from an incarcerated brother in Christ. The following is from a teaching he presented to other believing inmates at Walker State Prison.

Scripture focus: Genesis 1:27, "God created man in his own image; in the image of God he created him; male and female, he created them" (ESV).

We are going to look at scripture that tells us what makes all life matter to God the Father and creator and why it should matter to us. Our relationship to God is to be the foundation for all our relationships.

I received a correspondence from a Bible study mentor just days ago. He shared with me a Greek word for "man." Anthropos is that Greek word, a generic term meaning "mankind." It speaks of the solidarity of the species (**species is both singular and plural; there is no such word as specie**), the common humanity that we all have. This breaks the barrier of race. It breaks the social barrier as well. All men are on one level before the cross. For those who have not been saved by the blood of Christ, that level is sinner. I was a sinner. Whoever you are, if you do not belong to the Lord, you are a sinner in God's sight. Understand that I do not say that I never sin, but I do not live in sin. A sinner is one who lives a life of sin.

I don't know how many of you even watch TV, but there is a commercial where two little boys, one black and one white, both around three-years-old, were about ten feet from one another. When they saw each other, their faces lit up with smiles and they ran to one another. They were doing the classic kid-run – you know, stutter-stepping – and it looked like they were about to fall with their arms outstretched to one

another. When they reached each other, they embraced like long lost brothers being united for the first time since being separated. But that was not so. They were not long lost brothers or any kin at all. They were not even of the same race. None of that, however, seemed to matter to them. At that point in their lives, they only knew three things: friends, love and play. They had no knowledge of racial bias or discrimination. These things must be taught.

Kids just want to love and be loved and play with their friends in solidarity. When I was a kid growing up in Detroit, the neighborhood was black and white and we played in one of the vacant lots. There was always someone in our circle of friends who had one near his house and it became our playground that day. We would play our hearts out, loving each other as children do. We played into the evening and ended up lying in a pile together, exhausted from a good time.

It was all good in the hood until somebody was introduced to racism and brought it around. None of us is born with any sort of racism. Racism and hatred are learned behaviors. It is well known that in the early stages of life morals and values are shaped and formed. Unfortunately, some children become adapted to the morals and values of godless people. Anyone who says they know God and teaches hate or separation of mankind (segregation on account of race), that person is a liar according to the word of God. I John 4:8 says, "Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love." I John 4:20 says, "If someone says, 'I love God,' and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not seen?"

I have some good news for you: in the good news of the Bible, God tells us what makes a man's life matter. After all, In Ps 139:14 David said we are fearfully and wonderfully made. Everything that God made was good (Gen 1:31). Our focus scripture, Gen 1:27, tells us we were created in the image of God. Ps 8:5 tells us we were made a little lower than the angels. Acts 17:26 says he made from one blood every nation of men. That one blood can be traced back to Adam and we know the story of Adam and Eve in the garden. Their sin makes all mankind born into sin and without Jesus Christ, all men are sinners.

Easy Greezy Chriztianity

Elijah challenged the prophets of Baal that which ever god answered with fire, then he is God. The prophets of Baal danced around and acted silly. Then, when they were finished, Elijah poured water over the offering to be burned with fire. Why? He wanted to leave no doubt. If Yaveh was God, then he could burn up the offering and the water and there was nothing in the power of man that could stop it.

The application is this: After being told we would never have another baby, God enlightened me with this story, and instead of asking for one baby, I asked for two; I got twins. My wife Crystal would need a womb if we were going to have a baby; so I began to pray for a baby. Not long afterwards, our daughter Josalynn came into our lives.

I fell through a deck last year on the 4th of July. My back had already been injured years

ago, (12 bulging disks, arthritis, pinched nerves and a disk that is actually pushed through a vertebra and is touching another disk) but after the deck accident I was in pain. I never thought I would work again really. I kept asking God to heal my back and finally, God said "I can't heal your back because you haven't forgiven them" (the company I worked for when I first got injured).

After all that, I finally told God, "Okay, I'm going back to work in pain. The first day back, I was in pain big time. On the second day back there was no pain. I have not been in any pain now for over two months. For the first time in 20 years, I have not been in pain.

My point is this: We, as humans, try to make things easier for God. That is one reason that too many "salvations" some preachers talk about are just not real. "All you have to do is..." [then they name whatever it is, like 'Get down on one knee and confess every sin' or 'repeat after me' or some other thing the person has to do]. Done that way, it all depends on us. That's how you can tell it's not real. Jesus said "ye must be born again." To be born again means that your human spirit is brought back to life, it is born and you become a three-part person in the image of the triune God. You become a spirit, a soul and a body, just as God is Father, Son and Holy Spirit. After you are born again, then you begin to do things like as described on Rom 10:9, where it says "If you confess the Lord with your mouth and believe in your heart, you will be saved." That scripture is not a formula for salvation; it is the fruit of salvation. A person who is born again confesses Christ and believes in their heart.

It is our attempt to make things easier that has made the church so weak. "If you will just do this or do that then..." Any formula that takes the active work of the Spirit of God out of it and can be done by man, can then become a **talisman**. People call on the name of Christ because they believe it will help them. People are told to confess and believe like its a lucky charm. Heck, the truth is, it can turn right into charismatic witchcraft. "If you will just nod your head..." "If you will just raise your hand..." "If you will just give your money..." There was a time during the dark ages when the priests would say "if you will just take communion ..." "If you will just say 25 Hail Marys ..." "If you will just give money..." See the similarities?

Jesus said to his disciples, "Can you not pray for one hour?" He did not try to make it easier. I used to go about praying the sinner's prayer with people, then would marvel at how there was no real change in their lives (and I'm not saying it never works, God is gracious and good, but look at the weak, non-essential church we have today and show me all the great "fruit." There are more fruits than fruit).

God reminded me that I did not say a prayer, but rather I prayed for several weeks in the midst of drug addiction, "Lord, if you are real, I need your help." I would say that every day. After several weeks, suddenly, Jesus showed up and set me free. It was something **he** did, not something I did. That was almost 27 years ago. I honestly do not mean to offend or to challenge anyone's ministry tactics. Please, do not try to live by **my** convictions nor anyone else's. But, we need to stop trying to do it all ourselves. We need to stop selling God short. **He** is able, but **he** is not a microwave. He's not a fast mover

most of the time. He wants us to be serious about things like this. If we really want it, then he shows up. John the Baptist said to the Pharisees, "... bring ye fruits worthy of repentance..." In other words, prove you mean business. Elijah proved he meant business and God consumed the sacrifice with fire and even licked up the water with the flames. Call on the name of Jesus, but don't stop; keep calling on him until he answers. Then you will know. Then you will be changed. Then it will not be you managing your sin but it will be him delivering you from it.

I might've told somebody in 2013 that I did not see this unity thing working. It is 2020 and I do see it working. Many are working toward it; not just one.







pastor, and your body of believers would be included, we will get to your church eventually, but don't wait until next year. The Lord may come for his bride before that. Contact us. Those who stand with the WBCA don't make the mistake of believing that to be in unity, we must never disagree on anything. You do not see that even in nuclear families. Nor do we make the mistake of thinking we must all believe exactly the same thing. That will never happen.

We believe that there are eight principles that must be considered when establishing sound doctrine and criterion for unity. There may be a few more, but definitely not less nor significantly more, other wise we border on works of the law, rather than works of faith. They are:

1: Humans are born with a sin nature; all have sinned and without Christ, are worthy of hell, not fit for heaven.

2: Yeshua (Jesus) is the messiah, the spotless Lamb of God, and in fact, is God himself, the second member of the Godhead, not a second God: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

3: Christ the Messiah was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of a virgin (Miriam also called Mary, and sinless.

4: Jesus (Yeshua) died on the cross for your sins and mine.

5: Almighty God the Father raised Messiah (Jesus) from the dead on the third day.

6: Christ will return for his bride at the appointed time of the Father.

7: The Holy Bible is completely trustworthy, for it is inspired by the Holy Spirit.

8: Blatant sin (living in sin) is intolerable and the Community of Messiah (Church) must not tolerate it from its own.

Rick, “the burden of learning is on the teacher. I will not bore you with my opinion of how ridiculous that is. In college, however, the burden of learning is on the student, as it should be. I spent many years in college and learned how to learn, how to study. I have been able to apply that ability to learning the word of God. If I come to church, a Bible study or any sort of meeting and do not bring something to take notes with, it is like going to pick berries and not even bringing a bag to put them in. If I don't bring something to write with, I didn't really come to get anything. With all that being said, Pastor Joseph has suggested that we look at where we have been and where we are going.

“From 2010 to 2014, we did a lot of outreach, both to new churches and ministries as well as to individual people. By 2015, however, this began to drop off. In the beginning we gave out the Battlefield News in person and, therefore, stayed in contact with the churches.

“In the beginning we had the ministry schools. There was one for kids that lasted a couple of months, but complacency of the adults brought it to an end. The ministry school for adults began in 2013, but became so filled with religiosity and churchianity that it shut down after a couple of months as well.

“We have come together and gone door-to-door in neighborhoods around our churches. It was pretty successful, but we haven't done it in a few years. When we did it, we would have 30 people commit to be there, but four to six would actually show up.

“We dragged the cross through a few neighborhoods as well and it was pretty successful.

“The seven-day revival has been increasing in its successfulness until the virus came in early 2020. The coffee houses were making a pretty good comeback as well until the virus.

“I have never much liked it when I heard some preacher dwelling on what is wrong with his people or the church or the world without talking about what should and/or could be done differently. Therefore let's talk about some of the things that could be done to grow the alliance and to carry out the Great Commission. With that said, the floor is open for questions and suggestions.”

Let there be participation by all of us in the seven-day revival on more than one night, on nights when we are not speaking. The reason we have so many speakers every night, I think, is because so many people only show up when they are speaking. There's no reason for people not to know where it is or when it is or how to get there. That's always in the Battlefield News, which is free.



“We need some hearers too, people with discernment to hear. When Jesus died on the cross, the devil thought he had won, but... Jesus said, ‘All power has been given unto me.’ He also said he wants us to be in unity: ‘I in them and you in me, **that they may become perfectly one**, so that the world may know that you sent me’ (John 17:20-23, ESV).

“Father, clean me from the inside out. We have been complaining. The Children of Israel (Jacob) complained and they had to spend an extra 40years in the wilderness. That is where the church is now, wandering in the wilderness.

“God set the members in the body as it pleased him. We are one body, one community in Christ, not many bodies. Do you wanna please him? Do what he says to do: be in unity; find out what he called **you** to do and do it the best you can. If the members were all one member, where would the body be? What if every one in here was a foot? How would there be any listening? What if everyone was an apostle? What if all were teachers? We need **all** the gifts, like for instance, the gift of helps. Now we’re back to the word ‘love.’ Encourage others and watch ‘em grow. When you get angry with a brother, go to God. Don’t grumble and complain. It’s very important that we not hurt one another because ‘church hurt’ is gonna get a lot of people in Hell. Let love cover everything.

“V₂₆ – if one member suffers, all the members suffer. If one rejoices, all rejoice. If you cannot do that, you are not in unity with the rest of the body. ‘He is not any better than me; why did he get it and not me?’ Don’t let your pride take you there; love. If you’re grumbling, you’re not gonna get anything. Instead, hold on to God; he will come against whatever is coming against you. If he did not call you to do something, don’t do it; it won’t work. If we act like we know better than he does, he’s not gonna give us anything. He will do it all for us, but we have to give it **all** to him.”

God does not want cancer to get your lungs because then you cannot bless him. ‘Bless the Lord, oh my soul, and forget not all his benefits, who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases’ – all that is within me; blood, mind, voice. All the diseases going around will not get you. America is blessed. You say you have unemployment. You have not seen real unemployment. Go to Ghana and you will see real unemployment. Give thanks to God.”

(BFN Note: Most English translations of Mat 7:1 say something like, “Judge not lest ye be judged.” Mat 7:1 is one of the most misunderstood verses for Christians. It is almost definitely one of the most inappropriately quoted verses by those in the world. “You can’t judge me” is something we hear often, especially from people in the world. This thinking is very faulty and shows

a deficiency of understanding.

If Mat 7:1 is telling us not to make a judgment call concerning people, then it is a contradiction because just a few verses later in V₆ the Lord said, "Give not that which is holy unto the dogs, neither cast ye your pearls before swine." What is he saying here? Would you actually give your Bible to your dog? Would you actually give a string of pearls to a group of pigs? Yeshua (Jesus) so often was figurative in his speech. In the New Testament he seemed so rarely to be literal. He is not talking about dogs and pigs; he is making an analogy about people. One cannot carry this out without making a judgment call. We have to judge, to evaluate the situation and sometimes the person. The Bible says we will **judge** angels.

The Greek word here rendered "judge" is krino. It does mean judge, but another meaning is "condemn." Condemn not lest ye be condemned. People that wear T-shirts and hats that say "You can't judge me" or "Only God can judge me" are displaying a lack of understanding. They had better hope that we, the children of God, judge them and not the Living God.)

by Ms Mary's House of Hope, "instead of giving gifts for Christmas, went to Haiti. The earthquake in 2010 made many orphans. While we were there, we met a man and his wife who adopted 30 of them. This man said to me,

'Mama Linda, before you leave, you must hear my children sing to you.' I thought 'No way; I just wanna get outta here.' My husband David said we would love to. They sang *This Little Light of Mine* in five languages and I lost it. I know I heard the Lord say, 'This is the real joy of the Lord. You don't have it because your happiness depends on your circumstances.' Most people in the US have everything they need and most of what they want. We adopted five orphaned children and I left there a completely different woman.

"While the Haitian Children's Choir was on tour in 2018, I hooked up with Jody. Now, in 2020, we are about to open a hospital in Haiti. It opens on 29 August in the middle of a pandemic. Satan cannot stop it. A month ago we needed a shipping container sent to Haiti for the opening of the hospital. We had to have a driver to take it to be shipped. The kids remembered that Jody did that sort of thing. She came and packed with us like a work horse and arranged for the container to be shipped.

"Remember what Jody pushes: we are to be unified. God, however, does not use good and evil together. With the hospital open people no longer have to go to the Voodoo doctor, but to a hospital where they can be healed physically **and** spiritually."

"I'm glad my kids are in jail and not dead. Don't ever let somebody make you feel guilty for how your adult children act.

"Phil 4:8, '...whatever is true, honorable, just, pure, lovely, commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.' If you do this, you won't have time for gossip or negative things.

"I lived in a shelter for over a year. We are put in positions we don't like, but our attitude during those times will determine our future. God will place you where your greatest ministry opportunity is. Over 500 girls have come through Ms Mary's House of Hope. Many graduated, got their kids back after DFACS took them. During this time I have battled demon after demon with these women: lesbianism, unclean spirits of drug addiction, unclean spirits of almost any kind you can name. Life is a journey.

"Prov 3:5-6, 'Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him and he will guide your paths.' You don't have to tell everybody you're a Christian; just live it."

"We have had record numbers of people show up this week at the revival in spite of Covid-19. We helped Linda get the shipping container where it needed to be. That's how we get the

Battlefield News into China, Saudi Arabia and all over, but with Linda we are fighting Voodoo. No one is an island. We can do this. It is going all over the world. It really does."

"Our call is a call to battle, a call to overcome. Mat 24:12-13, what **will** be the signs of the last days? Because of lawlessness, the love of many will wax cold. They don't have the love of God. Rev 2:4, 'you have abandoned your first love,' the love you had when you first became a Christian. We are living in a time of great danger, fear and panic. Sometimes white people drive past me and lock their car doors. It's understandable; we are living in the last days. It is a time of satanic presence. It is in our atmosphere. Look, covid-19 is satanic. Paul told Timothy all this would happen. People want to go and make money; the Bible says that unless the Lord builds the house, the workers labor in vain. In the end, they will have nothing to show for it. People love self more than God.

"Have you ever been in love? Think how much time, energy and sacrifice was involved. We want to be with them every day and share everything with them. Then eventually we did not care any more? In Mat 26, Jesus told Peter, James and John to stay, watch and pray. But he came back and they were asleep. Did their love wax cold? They were sleeping. If you cannot pray for one hour, your love has waxed cold. I came to revive your love.

"As a child of God, are you sleeping? In these

last days, we need revival that will reconnect our love of God. It is our love of God that makes us overcomers. The enemy wars against you. Stand strong against demonic oppression. He tries to make your love wax cold.

"Fasting is not eating a different kind of food. There is no such thing as a Daniel fast. Fasting is abstaining from food. It makes you strong. It also has physiological benefits. People talk about a Daniel fast, an Isaiah fast, this fast, that fast. Try a Jesus fast: 40 days and 40 nights.

"Get up in the morning and read your Bible to wake up and pray for one hour. The blood will empower you."

"The WBCA," began Bishop James Walker at the sixth installment of the July 2020 seven-day revival, "We knew what we were getting into when we signed up for it. We are trusting in the word of God, Ps 91. We are putting action into what we speak. The virus is from the devil. It is up to the body of Christ to make this right. We are living in a time where, to the world, no means yes and vice versa, where good is called evil and evil is called good. If we are not seeing unity, it is not God's fault; it's ours.

I Peter 2:6-8, 'they stumble because they disobey the word of God as they were destined to do.' This is the devil, but he is not doing it without God's permission. God is doing some shaking. I wanna see all of you standing when the shaking is over.

"Mat 24:8-12, there will be a lot of iniquity and because of lawlessness, the love of many will wax cold. Even the love of many in the church

will be waxing cold. I'm not sure who of us will be in the kingdom. Look at how important this is: it is because of that love that the world will know we are of Jesus, but back biting tells them something else. Because Jesus died for **our** sins, when your brother has a problem with you, **you** go and try to make it right. When we put an offense under the blood, God can help us with it.

"Is 30:1, 'Ah, stubborn children,' declares the Lord, 'who carry out a plan, but not mine...'

Prov 17:11, 'An evil man seeks only rebellion...' Rom 13:1-2, 'Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God... those who resist will incur judgment.' II Tim 3:1-5, '...in the last days... people will be lovers of self, lovers of money... lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God...' Is 1:19-20, 'If you are willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land; but if you refuse and rebel, you shall be eaten by the sword...' When we become complacent, our love begins to decrease.

"Eph 4:1-6, '...maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit – just as you were called to one hope, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in y'all.' Be like Jesus more now than ever. When there is unity, it will begin in God's house."



Pastor Patsy Sherwood of Arcade CH Church

"Division destroys, especially division from the Father. From Genesis to Revelation, Jesus and the Father are together always. When Jesus hung on the cross, he had his own opinion, but he said, 'Not my will but ...' When we leave here, that's when the rubber meets the road. Change is from the inside out. I need to be concerned with **my** change, not everybody else's.

"Sometimes we hear the word and **still** allow the enemy to steal our seeds. No matter how close you are to God, you can get closer. Who would've thought five years ago that we could not go into a store without wearing a mask? We need to be careful, but more than just being careful, we need the protection of God. "Unity is not just a good thing, it's a **God** thing. United we are far more powerful.

"John 17:23, '...that they become perfectly one' If Yeshua prayed for it, it must be pretty important. Unity is necessary and tied to spreading the gospel. Satan does whatever he can to thwart outreach. He knows that disharmony always works and a great way to get it is to get the church to argue over unimportant things. Then they become inwardly focused and there is no outreach.

"II Chron 30:12, 'The hand of God was also on Judah to give them one heart to do what the king and the princes commanded by the word of the Lord.' Don't mistake diversity for disunity or vice versa. People who are not doing what we are doing, who have never attempted it, don't understand it very well. Unity keeps the church body growing and working.

"I Cor 12:12, '...are one body, so it is with Christ.' Eph 4:3, 'maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.' Unity flows from love and love unites the church. Without love there is no unity.

"Unity keeps Christ at the center (Eph 1:10) of us – selflessness, not selfishness. My feelings and plans are nothing compared to the gospel. Alone we can do so little, but together so much."



Sharon Bryant of Everything Under the Son Ministries

"Last year (2019) on 5 September I had neck surgery and I woke up paralyzed. I have missed all the revivals until now. God gave me the word, 'Together.'" Ms Sharon gave a definition of "together." Last year we had some problems in Hoschton. There was a tavern that decided to become a strip bar. We all came together at Anointed Hands with Dr Kenneth and Dr Lorrie and prayed while the strip bar was in operation. It was a packed house (see BFN 97, Feb 2019). The next day the parking lot was littered with trash, half-drunk beer and liquor containers and the like. The mayor appeared to me to be trying to sweep the whole thing under the rug. Then also in Hoschton we had a separation because of racist remarks by someone in the town government, but God saw a way to clean it all up. The bar's license did not get renewed and is now closed down. A whole new mayor and town council was put in place. All of this was because we came **together**.

"In I Cor 1:10, Paul wrote that we should have **no divisions** among us, that we be 'united in the same mind and the same judgment.' The Greek is Skhisma, a split or gap, a schism. In the body of Christ there is no gender, or race, no color, no Jew or Gentile. This song reminds me of the Whole Body of Christ Alliance." She played the song *Together*.



Pastor Russell Page of Kingdom Realm

"We've all been dealt a hand. What you've been

dealt is what you have to play with. Some have been bluffing. It's up to you to win and with God it's a win-win situation. 


