On Prayer 93 Call to Prayer (Part Five)

"The word of God is one of the primary instruments through which the Holy Spirit works. It is the sword of the Spirit in more than one sense. The people who want to know the Holy Spirit in any direction must feed upon the word. The person who desires to pray in the spirit must meditate on the word, so that the Holy Spirit may have something through which he can work. The Holy Spirit works his prayers in us through the word. Neglect of the word makes praying in the Holy Spirit an impossibility. If we seek to feed the fire of our prayers with the fuel of God's word, all our difficulties in prayer will disappear."

When we meditate upon God's word, we will begin to see his thoughts. When we see his thoughts and pray them, we will experience the delight of knowing his ways. The Bible promises, "Blessed is the man who walks not in the council of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful; but his **delight is in the law of the Lord, and in his law he meditates day and night.** And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper" (Ps 1:1-3 NKJV).

Can there possibly be a better way? The prophet Yesha'yahu (Isaiah) pointed out the great divide between God's thoughts and ours: "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways,' declares the Lord" (Is 55:8 NIV). Praying the word of God and meditating on it bridges the gap between our humanity and the divinity of the Lord. As we express his thoughts in prayer, we learn to walk in his ways.

In the case of George Mueller, we know that his prayers in accord with God's word brought miraculous results. Expressing his needs and the needs of his orphans to God alone through faith brought everything that was required for daily provision and it ushered countless souls into the kingdom of God.

James 1:6-8 says, "But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea that is driven and tossed by the wind. For that person should not suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways" (ESV). Mueller's prayer life was a powerful, living affirmation of this truth.

As previously noted, our faith increases by praying and hearing from God. When we meditate on his word, know it, understand him and therefore hear from him (it may not be audible), we begin to cease our wavering because we have heard from God and learn to believe that God will accomplish his word in our lives

Yeshua assures us of this truth: "Whatever you ask for in prayer, trust that you are receiving it, and it will be yours" (Mark 11:24 JNT). Listen to the words of another great prayer warrior, Andrew Murray, who wrote: "The more heartily we enter into the mind of our blessed Lord [Yeshua], simply thinking about prayer as he thought, the more surely his words will become living seeds. They will grow and produce their

fruit in us -a life corresponding exactly to the truth they contain. Do let us believe this: Christ, the Living Word of God, gives, in his words, a divine quickening power which brings what they say, which works in us what he asks, and which actually enables us to do everything he demands."

DL Ruins Everything On the Sabbath

I did not go to church much as a child, but my grandfather was a Pentecostal minister. When ever I spent the weekend with him, I went to church. I noticed that it was always on Sunday. Many years later I came to Messiah and I began to read the word of God. In Genesis I saw, "And God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made" (Gen 2:3 KJV).

Later, I also read, "Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the Lord your God. In it you shall do no work... ...for in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea and all that is in them and rested the seventh day. Therefore, the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it" (Ex 20:8-11 NKJV). This is the section of the book of Exodus (Sh'mot) where the Ten Commandments are introduced. This was the fourth commandment.

At some point in my childhood I was told we went to church on Sunday because Sunday was the "Sabbath." I never thought much about it as a child. I mean everything was closed on Sunday in those days (1950s and 60s) so it fit. I assumed that since Sunday was part of the "weekend," it must be the seventh day. Sometime later I discovered that Sunday was actually the first day of the week. So what gives?

I was told later that, since the Lord rose from the dead on the first day of the week, that Sunday became the Sabbath. That kept me for a little while, but the problem was that I actually read and studied the Bible. I could not find one single thing in there that said that the Sabbath had been changed from the seventh day to the first day. I did see where the early church recognized that the Lord was resurrected on the first day and they called it "the Lord's day." Still, however, there was nothing that I could find that said the "Lord's day" was the Sabbath. I was still perplexed.

I asked a pastor the question, "Where in the Bible does it actually say that the Sabbath day was changed to Sunday?" He responded that I would find it in the fourth chapter of the book of Hebrews. I read it again, but found that nowhere in that chapter does it say that the Sabbath had been changed. The closest thing I saw was, "For if Joshua had given them rest, God would not have spoken later about another day" (Heb 4:8 NIV). That was the only thing in chapter four that even came close, but it still did not say that the Sabbath had been changed to Sunday.

I searched every translation I came across to find the place that said it was changed to Sunday. The KJV said in Heb 4:8, "For if Jesus had given them rest, then would he not afterward have spoken of another day." This brought up another problem: KJV says "Jesus,"

while the other major English translations say "Joshua." The NKJV, the NIV, the ESV, the NAB, CJB, JNT, ASV, ISV, RV, and the YLT all say "Joshua." Those people that believe the KJV is the absolute authority need to see mistakes in it like this one and there are many others. Knowing some Hebrew, it is easy to see how this mistranslation happened. Let me not digress, however. That problem is for another time.

Before any reader of this article jumps to a conclusion, let me assure you that I am not a Seventh Day Adventist, even though I have never seen anything in the doctrine (I am not familiar with all of their doctrine) of that denomination that I don't already hold as true. In addition, since an "adventist" is simply someone who believes that the Messiah will return just as he said he would, I do claim that. There are other Christian groups that do not recognize Sunday as the Sabbath as well.

After exhaustive study, there are some conclusions I want to present:

- 1: The original 11 disciples never spoke of any plans to change the day they recognized as the Sabbath to the first day. Although Sunday worship is wonderful, it is not the Sabbath. Worship of the Living God should be every day of the week.
- 2: There is not even a hint in the B'rit Khadashah (New Testament) that Yeshua (Jesus) or his remaining 11 disciples changed the day of Sabbath worship to Sunday.
- 3: Nowhere in the New Testament (B'rit Khadashah) is there a command to observe the Sabbath on the first day of the week as a memorial to the resurrection of Jesus.
- 4: There is no scriptural evidence that the disciples (the remaining 11 of the original 12) changed the Sabbath to Sunday. This strongly points to this change having been accepted in the Christian church after the Bible was written and all the 12 were deceased.

In addition to all this, there are some interesting

On 7 March A. D. 321, the emperor of Rome, Constantine the Great, issued the first civil Sunday law, compelling all people in the Roman Empire, except farmers, to rest on Sunday. This with five other civil laws decreed by Constantine concerning Sunday, set the legal precedent for all civil Sunday legislation from that time to the present.

In the fourth century, the council of Laodicea (the church that was neither hot not cold) sought to honor Sunday by abstaining from work on that day if at all possible, and prohibited Christian believers from abstaining from work on the Sabbath.

I have no choice but to realize that the Sabbath is not Sunday, nor has it ever been Sunday. It is the seventh day just as the word of God says. If you believe this is not true and you have conclusive proof (not just an argument) please write to D. L. Greenberg at the Battlefield News. "Godly unity is based on love. It stems from a heart issue. I have said this time and time again. If your heart is not truly fixed, you cannot walk in the unity of God. True repentance fixes the heart. When you repent and your heart gets fixed, you don't have to be concerned about the other people involved in what God has called you to do. If you are actually repentant and following the Lord, you will not employ the use of domination, intimidation or manipulation to get people to do what they are supposed to do. You can have enough confidence in vourself that you don't have to use those tactics.

"Amos 3:3 says, 'can two walk together except they be agreed?' (KJV) Most folks think that means that we have to agree with each other on everything or we cannot walk together. That is not at all true. You know that. We don't have to agree on everything to be able to walk together. That is actually an incomplete translation (Yes there are some of those in the King James) Amos 3:3 actually says, 'Do two people travel together without having so agreed?' In other words, can two travel together without having agreed to travel together? (CJB) Contrary to popular belief, this verse is <u>not</u> about being unequally

"A husband and wife, on the other hand, must not be unequally yoked. A house that is divided, cannot and will not stand. Churches split because of disunity just as a husband and wife become divorced because of disunity.

"We can disagree and still be friends, but if you are going to use domination, intimidation and manipulation, I cannot be your friend. Those things cause people to be messy and it is not of God.'

(The word that is translated from Greek as 'word' is actually *rhema*, which means the spoken word of God, not the written word of God, which would be *logos*.) 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



Matt Elrod, a deacon from Northside Presbyterian Church read Mark 6:45-52.

"It is so important that we go up into the hills to pray. He prayed for hours while his boys were out crossing the lake. Even though they were miles out on the lake (Lake Kinneret aka the Sea of Galilee is 13 miles long and eight miles wide), he could see they were having trouble because the wind was against them. He walked out there with them on the water. They had not quite grasped how important they were to him and how much he loved them. They were the beginning of the kingdom, but we <u>are</u> the kingdom.

"If you are insured by Allstate, you have good benefits, but with Geico you pay less and have the same benefits. I changed from the devil to Jesus. It's a fixed fight.

"Mohammed is not the way, Krishna is not the way, the Virgin Mary is not the way. Jesus is the one who shed his blood for you. Mohammed, Buddha and Zoroaster all have one thing in common: they're dead. We don't serve a great man who was once alive, but is now dead; we serve a great savior who was once dead, but is now alive. What you have to do is receive what he has already done.

"In 1973 I was on my way to Hell. I was afraid of the dark, afraid of dogs and afraid of death. I was afraid I'd go to sleep and wake up in Hell. I don't have any of those fears now. I have Jesus. It's a fixed fight.

Pastor Charles Champion sang I don't know what you came to do, but I came to praise his name. "He is our Lord. He owns us. We have to do what the master says and I am so glad. "In Ps 100 it says, 'Enter his presence with joyful songs (Ps 100:2 CJB). It also says, 'It is he who made us and not we ourselves (Ps 100:3 NKJV). The Lord asked, 'For what good will it be for a man if he gains the whole world, yet forfeits his soul?' (Mat 16:26 NIV). You <u>and</u> that money will end up in Hell. "Daddy, we love you. He has already blessed you. The Bible says, he 'hath raised us up <u>together</u>, and made us sit <u>together</u> in heavenly places in Christ Jesus' (Eph 2:6 KJV).

"I want you to meet a good friend of mine. He loves and trusts God: Pastor Michael Smith"

Hell is real with worms that eat you alive. Some women won't even put a worm on a hook to fish. Think about that. Read the fine print – the Bible. It tells you how not to go there, tells you how best to live. Most people (people in the world) don't want to do that. That's why they go to bed at night with a heavy conscience, go to

bed with fear. God is giving you a chance to fix it tonight.

"The Bible says if you <u>do</u> sin, you have an advocate: 'if anyone does sin, we have Yeshua the Messiah, the Tzaddik (righteous one), who pleads our cause with the Father' (I John 2:1 JNT). Rom 3:23 says, 'for <u>all</u> have sinned and fall short of the glory of God' (ESV).

"The blood of Jesus washes us, cleans us of sin. That's one reason we take communion. The unleavened bread (because the "last supper" was a Passover Seder) represents his body that was broken for us so that we would have the healing as it says in Is 53:4, 'It was our infirmities that he bore, our sufferings that he endured' (NAB). Is 53:5 says, '...by his stripes we were healed' (NAB). You don't have to accept high blood pressure, diabetes, arthritis or Corona Virus. Kick them out.

"By his stripes we were healed, by his blood we were forgiven. The wine (or grape juice) represents his blood that was spilled for us so that we would have the salvation he died to give us. Is 53:5 tells us, 'He was pierced for our offenses, crushed for our sins upon him was the chastisement that makes us whole' (NAB). Is 53:10-11 says, '...he gives his life as an offering for sin.....through his suffering, my servant shall justify many, and their guilt he shall bear' (NAB).

"Jesus gives us power. Mark 16:17-18 says, 'these signs will accompany those who do trust: in my name they will drive out demons, speak with new tongues, not be injured if they handle snakes or drink poison, and heal the sick by laying hands on them' (CJB). You don't get power for nothing. I walk in authority over the devil. It's a fixed fight. We already won.

"Years ago Evander Holifield was fixin' to fight Mike Tyson. Tyson was a bad boy, but he came up against Holifield. The devil is a bad boy, but he came up against Jesus. Jesus went into the devil's own territory, took the keys and led captivity captive. It's a fixed fight.

"In Mat 28:18 Jesus said, 'All power is given unto me in Heaven and in Earth' (KJV). And according to Mark 16:17-18, we have that power. It's a fixed fight.

"Ps 103:4 says, 'who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion' (NIV).

Those who stand with the WBCA don't make the mistake of believing that to be in unity, we must never disagree on anything. You do not see that even in nuclear families. Nor do we make the mistake of thinking we must all believe exactly the same thing. That will never happen.

We believe that there are eight principles that must be considered when establishing sound doctrine and criterion for unity. There may be a few more, but definitely not less nor significantly more, other wise we border on works of the law, rather than works of faith. They are:

1: Humans are born with a sin nature; all have sinned and without Christ, are worthy of Hell, not fit for Heaven.

2:Yeshua (Jesus) is the messiah, the spotless Lamb of God, and in fact, is God himself, the second member of the Godhead, not a second God: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

3: Christ the Messiah was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of a virgin (Miryam also called Mary) and sinless.

4: Jesus (Yeshua) died on the cross for your sins

5: Almighty God the Father raised Messiah (Christ) from the dead on the third day.

6: Christ will return for his bride at the appointed time of the Father.

7: The Holy Bible is completely trustworthy, for it is inspired by the Holy Spirit.

8: Blatant sin (living in sin) is intolerable and the Community of Messiah (Church) must not tolerate it from its own.

"No one can keep the law. We see in Rom 7 that the law cannot defeat sin. So Jesus came to suffer for you so that you would not suffer. Why do Christians suffer? They suffer because of sin. Why do people not come together? It is because of sin. If you run a stop sign, you get a ticket. There are consequences. The police do that because of the law. Rom 3:23 says, 'For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God' (KJV). All have sinned. Some think that means you sinned before you got saved, but you don't now. If they think about that, they know it's not true. You sin now too, sometimes, but you don't live in sin. We cannot continue to live in sin anymore.

"Rom 6:2 says, 'How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it?' (NKJV) Rom 6:11 adds, 'In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus' (NIV). We must die to the flesh. I Pet 2:21-22 tells us, 'For to this you have been called because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example so that you might follow in his steps. He committed no sin, neither was deceit found in his mouth' (ESV). I Pet 4:1-2 also says, 'Therefore, since Christ suffered also in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same attitude (for whoever suffers in the flesh has broken with sin). So as not to spend what remains of one's life in the flesh on human desires, but on the will of God' (NAB). Fleshly suffering is a result of bad decision making.

"Am I worried about what will happen tomorrow? No! Concerned? Yes. Worried? No. Worry is a sin. We must trust God.

"It's a problem sometimes agreeing with sin. Is it okay to sleep around? No, but it's in the church: 'I know you two are not married, but just come to church and give us your money.'

"Old wounds cause suffering as well. This is not just in the world, it's in the church. People get mad at the pastor and go to another church. They don't talk to the pastor, they just leave. Others get mad at the pastor and go start their own church. That is rebellion. God does not like rebellion. This is a problem. To get to the solution to the problem we must get to the root of the problem.

"Jesus took our sins to the cross and set us free with his blood. The world will tell you it's okay to take drugs, commit fornication – have sex when you're not married, commit or support abortion or practice homosexuality. If you vote for a person who supports abortion, homosexual marriage, men dressing as women or wanting to have a right to use the woman's bathroom, or women who want to pretend they are men (the devil has always used blurring of the lines of gender; it was a problem in New Testament Greece. But nowadays the world helps him do it), then you <u>are</u> supporting these things. No wonder people are confused and messed up. No wonder their hearts are not right. Sin separates us from God. Nothing but the blood of Jesus can wash away my sins. Sin will keep us from reaching our potential in Jesus.

"In Rom 12:1-2 we see, 'I exhort you, therefore, brothers, in view of God's mercies, to offer yourselves as a sacrifice, living and set apart for God. This will please him; it is the logical "Temple worship" for you. In other words, do not let yourselves be conformed to the standards of the olam hazeh (this world). Instead, keep letting yourselves be transformed by the renewing of you minds; so that you will know what God wants and will agree that what he wants is good, satisfying and able to succeed' (JNT). If that is what we are supposed to do, then why do we act like the world? I am qualified because of what Jesus did; I do not have to set up a payment plan. He died once for us. Why can't we do it once?

"People say the 'Sinner's Prayer,' go back out

and still live in sin, but think they are on their way to Heaven. Jesus did not tell us to make all nations say the 'Sinner's Prayer;' He told us to make **disciples** of all ethnos (all groups of people).

"I'm gonna let this little light shine. It may get dim sometimes, but it will still be shining. Don't go back to the graveyard and resurrect the old man. We gotta be an example for church folks to follow. We can't expect the people in the church to get it right if the pastor doesn't have it right. Almost all of you are pastors and ministers. You are a royal priesthood; act like one.

"Eric can lead you into worship, but it's up to you to worship. Pastor Roger can lead you to the word of God, but it's up to you to get in the word of God. Come out of the world and be transformed by the renewing of you mind."

Herman Parks the Bible teacher of the Alternative View

"We say, 'I love my mother,' but we also say 'I love hot dogs, I love hunting, nature, trees, grass, weapons.' Some people are even 'in love' with the concept of being 'in love.' We use the word to explain behaviors. 'I did it because I love her.' A man in an adulterous relationship may call it love, while the preacher calls it sin. The wife of an alcoholic picks up the pieces of the messes her husband leaves because she loves him, but a psychologist would call it co-dependence. Some parents let their children run wild because they love them, but others may call it irresponsible parenting.

"Agape is not an emotion; it is an action, a behavior. We don't agape <u>because</u>; we agape <u>in spite of</u>. Agape is unconditional, phileo is not. You don't love your best bud except upon condition.

"In Greek, the language in which the New Testament was written, there are at least five words for love (Actually there at least seven: agapao, agape', philautos, philotheos, philos [or phileo] and eros). In John 21:15-17 we see, 'Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you love [agape] me more than these?" He [Peter] said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love [phileo] you." He [Jesus] said to him, "Feed my lambs." He [Yeshua] said to him [Peter] a second time, "Simon Son of John, do you love [agape] me?" He [Peter] said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love [phileo] you." He [Yeshua] said to him, "Tend my sheep." He [Yeshua] said to him the third time, "Simon son of John, do you love [agape] me?" Peter was grieved because he [Jesus] said to him the third time, "Do you love me?" and he [Peter] said to him, "Lord, you know everything: you know that I love [phileo] you." Jesus said to him [Peter], "Feed my sheep" (ESV).

"Jesus is asking, 'Do you have God's love for other's because of me?" Feelings change, but agape is eternal.

"Jesus went on in John 21:18 to tell Peter that he would die because of his love for the flock.

"Jesus called himself the good shepherd and he came establishing the kingdom. When he said he came for the lost sheep, he was equating himself with God. He knew he was leaving. So he was leaving Peter in charge of the church.

"Yeshua asked Peter if Peter had unconditional love for him. He did not mean without feeling; he meant irrespective of feelings. Even the publicans knew how to love their own. Peter answered that the best he had was philos. Jesus asked again. It was a teaching lesson. Yeshua told him, 'Feed my sheep," and he said, "Keep my commands" regardless of how you feel. Feelings change, but agape is forever. Jesus loved us when we did not love him – agape."



Pastor Mary Tate conducted the Battlefield News offering

"It says a dollar on it, but you can't put a price on a soul. It goes into jails and more countries than you can count overseas, every continent but Antarctica. It helps folks all over, helps with hurts habits and hang-ups, even people tore up from the floor up."



Pastor Isaac Amoah was the main speaker. "Paul wrote about a thorn in the flesh that was given to him: 'Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart

from me. And he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my strength is made perfect in weakness" (II Cor 12:8-9 NKJV). He said he would, therefore, boast of his infirmities. Paul had different graces. Even his handkerchief healed people. Whatever your issue, his grace is sufficient. There are different levels of grace, different types. Paul began to understand that.

"There is a grace that will make all things possible in your life. In Gen 40:1, Yosef (Joseph) was in prison, '...the cup bearer and the baker of the king of Egypt offended their master, the king of Egypt' (NIV). 'And one night they both dreamed - the cupbearer and the baker of the king of Egypt, who were confined in prison - each his own dream...' (Gen 40:5 ESV). 'After a lapse of two years Pharaoh had a dream'(Gen 41:1 NAB). The king's cupbearer remembered Yosef (Joseph) and said to Pharaoh, 'A young Hebrew was there [in prison] with us... ... We told him our dreams and he interpreted them... ... and things turned out exactly as he interpreted them to us' (Gen 41:12-13 NIV). There was the grace that caused them to remember Joseph in prison.

"The Lord said, 'I have come that they may have life, life in its fullest measure' (John 10:10 JNT). There is a grace of restoration.

"Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need' (Heb 4:16 KJV). God's grace comes when we come in our time of need. When you are before the throne of grace, things happen. We are to come boldly. The woman with the issue of blood approached Jesus with enough boldness to actually touch the tzittzit (tassels that hang from a garment that represent the 613 laws of Moses) of his robe in Luke 8:43-48. She said to herself, 'If only I may touch his clothes I shall be made well' (Mark 5:28 NKJV). God is calling you to come boldly. When people come to the food bank to get food, they come boldly. God is calling you to come boldly to get food for your spirit. Come obtain grace in your time of need. Come boldly."

Better Understanding of Unity in the Body

We seem to have some things a bit mixed up, folks. Our understanding of some of these things could be better. I keep hoping things will get better, and they have for some in the WBCA. Some are learning. Many, unfortunately, do not seem to be. We talk about unity. Some even work for it. We are all supposed to be putting effort into being in unity, into bringing all the people of Messiah into unity. There still seems to be much misunderstanding, and I believe that is what it is — misunderstanding.

We don't come together because we <u>are</u> in unity, even though we in the WBCA are in far better unity than most groups of believers. We come together because we are <u>not</u> in unity nearly as well as we need to be, especially looking at the dark times that are coming.

It seems that most people that are not with the alliance believe that being in unity means we agree on everything. Someone who did not stand with the WBCA spoke at one of the seven-day revivals where there was a disagreement between some of the people. This visitor told me that what they saw was disunity. Most of us in the WBCA realize that unity does not mean we will never disagree. People in the same church disagree. Members of the same nuclear family disagree. Agreeing on everything

is <u>not</u> going to happen. That is not what unity is. If we are unified we will stand together on the major issues; we will focus on what we have in common instead of our differences. Believing that unity means we never disagree is nonsense. People who do not work for unity in the body, (unfortunately most Christians), who have not heard of any of the alliances in this country (we are not the only ones; there are many), who are used to business as usual (which is rather ineffective), who are used to doing their own thing, do not understand unity in the body of Messiah only because they have not yet been part of much of it. We in the WBCA must <u>not</u> espouse such nonsense.

We are many different denominations, even many different **non**denominations. We do not all believe exactly the same things. Do not be discouraged by that fact. If you got five people in the same church, same denomination, taught by the same pastor, and sat them at a table and began discussing the word of God, sooner or later (probably sooner) they would disagree.

We are not going to agree on every piece of doctrine. A respected, wonderful and very wellmeaning Christian leader, addressing this very issue, once made the statement, "we'll let the word of God be the final authority." At first glace, so to speak, that sounds great. It's something we had all better be doing. Allowing the word of God to be the final authority, however, will never cause us all to believe exactly the same things. This is because any real Christian will not argue with the Bible. They will argue, on the other hand, with what **<u>you</u>** say it means, what \underline{I} say the author was talking about. If simply allowing the Bible to be the final authority would eliminate those doctrinal issues, then there would not be more than 9000 denominations in the US. I'm not even sure we should, at this point in God's plan, believe the same things anyway. Here's what I mean: There have been many things in my walk with the Lord that I held as true, but found later that they were not exactly the way I believed. Therefore, I had to change those things I believed that were not true. I have enough sense (hard to believe, right?) to realize that if there are things I used to hold as true that turned out not to be, then I stands to reason that there are things I now believe that I will later discover are not that way. This is true for every single one of us and if you don't believe it is true for you, you are very naïve and pretty full of yourself.

In addition, I have seen many denominations and cultish pastors that act as if they had the whole truth and nobody else did. This is a sign that spiritual inbreeding has taken place. The truth is that not even one denomination, church or pastor has the whole truth and **none** of us is going to get the whole truth until we come together into one real body, not under one pastor or denomination, not all believing exactly the same things like little Christian robots, but together loving each other, supporting each other even though we do not believe exactly the same things. We must stop trying to get everyone to believe exactly what we believe. We must stop focusing on our differences and focus on the wonderful things (like Jesus the Messiah) that we have in common. We in the WBCA (most of us) don't focus on our differences; we focus on our commonalities. There are eight things that we all agree on. Beyond these eight tenets, we don't strive to get everyone to believe exactly as we do.

We believe that there are **eight principles** that must be considered when establishing sound doctrine and criterion for unity. There may be a few more, but definitely not less nor significantly more, other wise we border on works of the law, rather than works of faith. They are:

- 1: Humans are born with a sin nature; all have sinned and without Christ, are worthy of Hell, not fit for Heaven.
- 2: Yeshua (Jesus) is the messiah, the spotless Lamb of God, and in fact, is God himself, the second member of the Godhead, not a second God: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.
- 3: Christ the Messiah was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of a virgin (Miryam also called Mary) and sinless.
- 4: Jesus (Yeshua) died on the cross for your sins and mine.
- 5: Almighty God the Father raised Messiah (Christ) from the dead on the third day.
- 6: Christ will return for his bride at the appointed time of the Father.
- 7: The Holy Bible is completely trustworthy, for it is inspired by the Holy Spirit.
- 8: Blatant sin (living in sin) is intolerable and the Community of Messiah (Church) must not tolerate it from its own.

A wise man once said, "If I were going to strive to control a society, I would not be concerned with being a law maker. Instead, I would want to control the lyrics to music, and the books written. I would want to control the movies (there are many propaganda movies that have been released even recently that have changed public opinion, changed society as a whole and not all for the better), the social media (to censor the truth) and especially the news media. Those are the things that influence the laws, not the other way around.

We are getting there, getting to unity in the body. The big question, however, is this: will we be able to work fast enough, will we be able to overcome our apathy, complacency and laziness in time to make the difference that is needed? Don't just think about it; get up off you pew and do something. You know what to do. God bless you all.

Flashback from April 2012 **Misunderstanding** Christianity

Last month I wrote about theology and how it was like a map to understanding God. In the days in which we live, understanding God has never been more important, especially in light of all the popular "religions" and the oceans of

misunderstanding about him. When you really get down to it, isn't the most common misunderstanding by the world about Christianity simply this: that Jesus Christ was a great moral teacher and that if we would only take his advice we would be able to establish a better society and avoid anymore wars? Even though that statement is very true, it tells us only a tiny fraction of the whole truth about Jesus and Christianity. Even though it may be quite true, the statement has no practical importance whatsoever.

Although it is quite true that if we took Christ's advice we would be living in a happier world, we don't even have to go as far as the teachings of Jesus. If we are hanging the betterment of our society on the mere following of some philosophy, we could accomplish that by simply following the far easier philosophies of Plato, Buddha, or even Mark Twain. In following any of their philosophies we would get along far better than we do. But my question to you at this point is: So what? We have never followed the advice of any great teacher. Why would we start now? Why would we be more likely to follow the teachings of Jesus than any of the others? Because he is the best moral teacher? Think about that one for a moment. The truth is that if he is the best moral teacher, we would be even less likely to follow him. We cannot even handle the elementary lessons. How likely is it that we will follow the most advanced? If Christianity only means one more bit of good advice, then Christianity is of no importance. There has been more than enough good advice over the last 4000 years. A bit more makes no difference at all. Let's not even go there.

As soon as we look at any of the real Christian writings, as soon as we look at the actual word of God, we see that they are as far from this worldly misconception about Jesus as the Easter Bunny is from the resurrection of Christ. These writings say that Yeshua (Jesus) is the Son of God (whatever that means). They say that those who place their confidence in him can also become sons of God (whatever that means). They say that his death saved us from our sins (whatever that means).

There is no point in complaining that these statements are too difficult to truly comprehend. Christianity claims to be telling us about another world – another existence, something behind that world that we can touch and hear and see. You may think the claim false; but if it were true, what it tells us <a href="https://has.ic.edu/has.ic.e

The part of Christianity that gives us the biggest problem is the statement that, by attaching ourselves to Christ, we can become "sons of God." Many would say, "Aren't we <u>all</u> God's children?" There are actually two answers to this question depending upon how we look at it. To answer it in the strictest sense, in a word, the answer is <u>no</u>. We are <u>not</u> all children of God. John 1:11-13 says, "He came unto his own and his own received him not. But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God."

On the other hand, the fatherhood of God is one of the main Christian principles. In a certain sense we are, no doubt, children of God already. I mean God has brought us into existence, he

loves us and takes care of us and in that way is like a father.

This may seem contradictory but, if you will indulge me for a moment, I will explain. Remember that the New Testament was originally written in Greek, not English. In English we use the word "children." In Greek, however, two words are used: hwee'-oss and tel-i-ah'-oh. The word hwee'-oss is more of a general reference to children. The same word can be used for babies, calves, puppies, etc. It is in this sense that we see the word used in Rom 8:14, 23 and it is this form of the word referred to in the use of the word "adoption" in Rom 8:15 and Gal 4:5. The word Tel-i-ah'-oh refers more to those who are actually begotten or born to someone as in John 1:12 or Rom 8:16.

You see then that when the Bible speaks about "becoming sons of God," obviously it means something else — something other than what most people mean when they speak of being children of God. And that brings us right to the very center of theology — we must use the map. One of the creeds says that Christ is the son of God, "begotten, not created": and it adds, "begotten by his father before all worlds." This is born up by scripture: John1:1 says, "In the beginning was the Word (Jesus), and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." In John 8:58 Jesus said, "Verily, verily, I say unto you, before Abraham was, I AM."

This is the point where it is so very important that you understand that this has nothing to do with the fact that Christ was born on earth to a woman who was a virgin. I am not speaking here about the phenomenon of virgin birth. Instead, we are discussing something that happened before Nature was created at all – before time began. "Before all worlds" Christ is begotten, not created. What does that mean?

Begotten verses Created: To beget is to become the mother or father of. To create is to make. When you beget, you beget something of the same kind as yourself. A woman begets human babies; a bird begets little birds and a bee begets little bees. But when you make, you make something of a different kind than yourself. A bird **creates** a nest, a beaver **creates** a dam, a bee **makes** a hive and a man **makes** a rocking chair — or he may create something more like himself, like a statue, or even a robot, which is very much like a man. But of course, it is not a real man; it only looks like one. It is incapable of breathing, digesting, or thinking. It is not

Now, that is the first thing we need to be clear on. What God begets is God; just as what man begets is man. What God creates is <u>not</u> God; just as what man creates is not man – regardless of how lifelike it appears. Even the most sophisticated computers do not actually **think**. This is the reason that men and women are not children of God in the sense that Jesus Christ is. They may be like God in certain ways, but they are not of the same kind as God. They are more like statues or pictures of God.

A statue has the shape of a man but it is not alive. In the same way, man may have the "shape" or likeness of God (I will explain), but he does not have life the way that God does. First of all, everything God made has some likeness to God. Space is like him in its hugeness. Not that the greatness of space is the same as God's, but it is sort of a symbol of it, or a translation of it into nonspiritual terms. Matter is like God in having energy: although physical

energy is a different thing than the power of God. The plant world is like him because it is alive and he is the "Living God." But life in the biological sense, is not the same as the life there is in God: it is only a kind of symbol or shadow of it. When we get to the animals, we find other kinds of resemblances in addition to biological life. The intense activity of insects, for example, is a first dim resemblance to the unceasing activity and creativity of God. In the higher mammals we get the beginnings of instinctive affection. That is not the same thing as the love that exists in God: but it is like it - kind of like a picture drawn on a flat piece of paper can be like a landscape. When it comes to people, the highest animals, we get the most complete resemblance to God that we are aware of. (There may be creatures in other worlds that are more like God than people are, but we are not aware of them.) People not only live, but love and reason: biological life reaches it highest known level in them.

What people do <u>not</u> have, at least in their natural condition, is spiritual life – the higher and different sort of life that exists in God. We use the same word for both in English – life. If, however, you thought that they were the same kind of life, that would be like thinking the greatness of space and the greatness of God were the same thing. In reality, the difference between biological life and spiritual life is so important that I am going to introduce the Greek words for these two kinds of life.

To understand these two separate words, let's take a look at scripture beginning with John 10:10. "The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly." Now let's look at John 20:31. "... that believing you might have life, through his name." When the angel of God freed the apostles from prison in Acts 5:20, he told them, "Go and stand and speak in the temple to the people all the words of this life." In each of these verses the Greek word used for "life" is ZOE' (Dzo-eh). It does not mean the kind of life we usually think about. Instead, it refers to the kind of life God has: spiritual life – Zoe'.

If we look at some other scripture, we can see the difference in the two meanings. In Luke 8:14 we see, "... are choked with the cares, and riches, and pleasures of this <u>life</u>." I Tim 2:2 says, "... that we may lead a quiet and peaceable <u>life</u> in all godliness and honesty." In Peter 4:3 it says, "For the time past of our <u>life</u> may suffice us to have wrought..." In each of these verses the Greek word for "life" is BIOS. This <u>is</u> the thing we mean when we speak of life.

You see the biological kind of life, which comes to us through nature, and which (like everything else in nature) is always running down and decaying so that it can only be kept up by being renewed from nature in the form of air, water, food, etcetera, is BIOS. The spiritual life which is in God from all eternity, and in which made the whole universe is Zoe'. Bios has a shadowy or symbolic resemblance to Zoe': But only the sort of resemblance there is between a photograph and a place, or a statue and a person. 


